EVENT TIME:	 AM tee times both Saturday and Sunday Call the Pro Shop the Friday evening prior to event for your round one tee time Please check-in 30 minutes prior to tee time or entry fee may be forfeited
EVENT DETAILS:	 Championship Flight The Sr. Club Champion is the 36-hole low gross score from the Championship Flight Championship flight must play from Gold tees, and the "One Ball Rule" is in effect Non-Championship Flights This will be a multi-tee event and you will play from your year long tee selection the "One Ball Rule" does not apply to non-championship flights Number of flights determined by the number of entrants All Competitors 100% of course handicap to be used for Net scores
PAYOUTS:	 Individual low gross and low net payouts per flight Players cannot win both gross and net prizes Optional skins, and/or other games will be available at the registration table Individual nearies on all par 3's included both Saturday and Sunday
ELIGIBILITY:	 In order to participate in the Club Championship each member must be 50 years of age as of the date of competition and have participated in one (1) of the following scenarios: Two (2) 18-hole major events. (Two-day events count as one event) One (1) 18-hole major event and Four (4) 9-hole Tuesday or Wednesday league events Eight (8) 9-hole Tuesday or Wednesday league events Any Previous Sr. Club Champion who is a current member in good standing

Tournament Rules

CROWN POINTS:	This event is worth 350 Crown Royal points.
SIGNATURE SHOWDOWN:	This event does NOT count towards players' year-long Signature Showdown scorecard; not all players are eligible to participate in this event.
EVENT RULES:	 For this format, all players will play their own ball for 36 holes (18 holes per day) The players should record the gross scores on each hole of the official score card Players should turn in completed, signed and attested scorecards to the scoring area within 15 minutes of completing the round
TEE SHOTS:	All players will be playing their own ball throughout this competition.
ONE BALL RULE:	 Championship Flight: The one ball rule IS in effect for this event. Players must use the same brand/model of golf ball through each 18-hole round of this competition. Players do have the option to switch ball models for the second round, but must use the new model ball throughout the second round. All Other Flights: The one ball rule is NOT in effect for this event.
NOTES:	 Player scores will be recorded as "Tournament" scores USGA rules will govern all play except where modified by this format Local rules sheets will be available at the registration table Each player's current USGA handicap the day before event will be used The handicap committee will review & may adjust all handicaps prior to event Players without a USGA handicap index will be reviewed by the handicap committee
LOCAL ETIQUETTE:	 Keep Pace with the group in front of you Wait to play until the players in front of you are out of range Replace your divots, or fill with sand/seed mix in the fairways Smooth all marks made in sand hazards, leaving the rakes in the hazards Keep power carts away from all tee boxes, hazards, and greens Fix damage to the greens, even if it is not yours Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed out
