## **Tournament Rules**

EVENT RULES:	<ul> <li>For this format all players shall play within/by the rules published at the time of the event, subject to the event format, which shall be decided by the membership</li> <li>The players should record the gross scores for each player on each hole of the official score card as determined by the format of play</li> <li>We will be using Golf Genius to submit scores in real time. A physical score card will still be required to turn in completed, attested and signed to the scoring area within 15 minutes of completing the round.</li> <li>Individual hole scores will be scored as written or converted to points based the event format</li> </ul>	
TEEING GROUNDS:	This is a <b>multi-tee</b> event. All play shall be from your year-long tee selection.	
TEE SHOTS:	To be determined	
ONE BALL RULE:	The one ball rule is <b>NOT</b> in effect for this event.	
NOTES:	<ul> <li>Player scores will be recorded as "Competition" scores</li> <li>USGA rules will govern all play except where modified by this format</li> <li>Local rules sheets will be available at the registration table</li> <li><i>Each player's current USGA handicap the day before the event will be used</i></li> <li>The handicap committee will review &amp; may adjust all handicaps prior to event</li> <li>Players without a USGA handicap index will be reviewed by the handicap committee</li> </ul>	
LOCAL ETIQUETTE:	<ul> <li>Keep Pace with the group in front of you</li> <li>Wait to play until the players in front of you are out of range</li> <li>Replace your divots, or fill with sand/seed mix in the fairways</li> <li>Smooth all marks made in sand hazards, leave rake in sand hazards</li> <li>Keep power carts away from all tee boxes, hazards, and greens</li> <li>Fix damage to the greens, even if it is not yours</li> <li>Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed out</li> </ul>
