EVENT FORMAT: This is a Flighted, Individual, 36-Hole, Medal Play Tournament

ENTRY TYPE: Sign up as an individual

- Hardcopies of this registration form along with cash or check payment may be placed in the men's club drop box in the Majestic Oaks Pro Shop
- · Payment must accompany entry form
- Make all checks payable to: Majestic Oaks Men's Club
- Registration payments on day of the event will incur a \$5 late fee

EVENT TIME: AM tee times both Saturday and Sunday

- Call the Pro Shop the Friday evening prior to event for your round one tee time
- Please check-in 30 minutes prior to tee time or an alternate will be allowed to play in your place, and entry fee may be forfeited

FORMAT DETAILS: Championship Flight

- Club Champion will be the 36-hole low gross score from the Championship Flight
- Any MOMC member can elect to play in the Championship Flight
- Championship flight must play from Green tees, and the "One Ball Rule" is in effect

All Other Flights:

- Will be Multi-Tee and flights based on handicap index, and number of entrants
- Players from multiple tee boxes may be within same flight
- All play shall be from your year-long tee selection.
- the "One Ball Rule" does not apply to non-championship flights

PAYOUTS:

- Individual low gross and low net payouts per flight
- Players cannot win both gross and net prizes
- Optional skins, and/or other games will be available at the registration table
- Individual nearies on all par 3's included both Saturday and Sunday

ELIGIBILITY:

In order to participate in the Club Championship each member must have participated in one (1) of the following scenarios:

- Two (2) 18-hole major events. (Two-day events count as one event)
- One (1) 18-hole major event and Four (4) 9-hole Tuesday or Wednesday league events
- Eight (8) 9-hole Tuesday or Wednesday league events
- Any previous Club Champion who is a current member in good standing

Tournament Rules

CROWN POINTS: This event is worth 350 Crown Royal points.

SIGNATURE SHOWDOWN:

This event does count towards players' year-long Signature Showdown scorecard.

EVENT RULES:

- For this format, all players will play their own ball for 36 holes (18 holes per day)
- The players should record the **gross scores** on each hole of the official score card
- Players should turn in completed, signed, and attested scorecards to the scoring area **within 15 minutes** of completing the round

TEEING GROUNDS:

- Championship Flight: All players must play from Green tees
- All other Flights: Multi-Tee All play shall be from your year-long tee selection.

TEE SHOTS: All players will be playing their own ball throughout this competition.

ONE BALL RULE:

Championship Flight: The one ball rule **IS** in effect for this event. Players must use the same brand/model of golf ball through each 18-hole round of this competition. Players do have the option to switch ball models for the second round, but must use the new model ball throughout the second round.

All Other Flights: The one ball rule is **NOT** in effect for this event.

NOTES:

- Player scores will be recorded as "Tournament" scores
- USGA rules will govern all play except where modified by this format
- Local rules sheets will be available at the registration table
- The handicap committee will review & may adjust all handicaps prior to event
- Players without a USGA handicap index will be reviewed by the handicap committee

LOCAL ETIQUETTE:

- Keep Pace with the group in front of you
- Wait to play until the players in front of you are out of range
- Replace your divots, or fill with sand/seed mix in the fairways
- Smooth all marks made in sand hazards, leaving the rakes in the hazards
- Keep power carts away from all tee boxes, hazards, and greens
- Fix damage to the greens, even if it is not yours
- Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed out
