EVENT FORMAT: This is a Flighted, Individual, 36-Hole, Medal Play Tournament

ENTRY TYPE: Sign up as an individual

- Hardcopies of this registration form along with cash or check payment may be placed in the men’s club drop box in the Majestic Oaks Pro Shop
- **Payment must accompany entry form**
- Make all checks payable to: *Majestic Oaks Men’s Club*
- **Registration payments on day of the event will incur a \$5 late fee**

EVENT TIME: **AM tee times both Monday and Wednesday**

- Call the Pro Shop the Sunday evening prior to event for your round one tee time
- Please check-in 30 minutes prior to tee time or an alternate will be allowed to play in your place, and entry fee may be forfeited

EVENT DETAILS:

- Master’s & Super Senior players must play from **Black** tees
- Players **can** win both Masters and Super Senior Championship if eligible
- Players **cannot** win both gross and net prizes
- 100% of course handicap to be used for Net scores

ELIGIBILITY:

- All players must be **62 years** of age as of the date of competition
- **Master’s Division:** players must be **70 years** of age as of the date of competition
- Player must be a current MOMC member in good standing and competed in at least one 2019 MOMC event to be eligible to compete

PAYOUTS:

- **The Super Senior Club Champion** will be the overall 36-hole low gross score of the players at least 62 years old.
- **The Master’s Club Champion** will be the overall 36-hole low gross score of those players who are eligible.
- If the Master’s Club Champion is the overall 36 hole low gross winner of the entire field of Super Senior & Master’s entry’s, they are eligible to win both divisions.
- Low gross and low net payouts per flight/division qualified for
- Number of places/payouts determined by the number of entrants
- Optional skins, and/or other games will be available at the registration table
- Individual nearies on all par 3’s included both Monday and Wednesday, All Flights Compete

Tournament Rules

CROWN POINTS: This event is worth 350 Crown Royal points.

SIGNATURE SHOWDOWN: This event does **NOT** count towards players' year-long Signature Showdown scorecard; not all MOMC members are eligible for this event.

EVENT RULES:

- For this format, all players will play their own ball for 36 holes (18 holes per day)
- The players should record the **gross scores** on each hole of the official score card
- Players should turn in completed, signed, and attested scorecards to the scoring area **within 15 minutes** of completing the round

TEEING GROUNDS: All players must play from **Black tees**.

TEE SHOTS: All players will be playing their own ball throughout this competition.

ONE BALL RULE: The one ball rule is **NOT** in effect for this event.

NOTES:

- Player scores will be recorded as "Tournament" scores
- USGA rules will govern all play except where modified by this format
- Local rules sheets will be available at the registration table
- The handicap committee will review & may adjust all handicaps prior to event
- Players without a USGA handicap index will be reviewed by the handicap committee

LOCAL ETIQUETTE:

- **Keep Pace** with the group in front of you
- **Wait** to play until the players in front of you are out of range
- **Replace** your divots, or fill with sand/seed mix in the fairways
- **Smooth** all marks made in sand hazards, leaving the rakes **in** the hazards
- **Keep** power carts away from all tee boxes, hazards, and greens
- **Fix** damage to the greens, even if it is not yours
- **Leave** the putting green as soon as you have holed out
